Built under licence by Curtiss on the 15th of December 1928 this beautiful and extremely rare metal-framed version of De Havilland's famous Moth is now being offered for sale.

Owned since 1986 by Hamish Moffatt an intrepid explorer and Bugatti racing car driver, G-AADR has spent her years since then on an idyllic rural farm strip in Herefordshire.

The Gipsy I engine was fully restored by Ed Clark in America, and has run just 147 hours since. The airframe, which has only flown 1283 hours, was restored by Bert Brooks. The aircraft also benefits from new tie rods which were fitted during 2017.
